INTERNATIONAL STUDENT MOBILITY

➤ Erasmus+ Programme KA1

EU funded mobility programme allowing you to spend between two and twelve months at a European or non European university.

➤ Joint degrees or double/multiple degrees

Offered in English and/or Italian, these courses, in accordance with agreements stipulated, provide integrated curricula and student mobility strategies allowing for the reciprocal recognition of the credits earned within the course. Graduates obtain a double or multiple degree (from the two or more universities taking part in the agreement in which the student has earned required credits) or a joint degree (a single degree issued by the universities who have officially agreed upon and established a joint international degree course).

➤ International agreements

Between the University of L'Aquila and EU or non-EU countries' universities, they are another means of internationalizing and promoting teaching and research on an international level.

Blended Mobility

The Erasmus+ programme for the period 2021-2027 has added new opportunities to the existing mobility activities, in order to enhance **flexibility, accessibility** and **relevance** of the mobility experience.


As a rule, any mobility that was previously an exclusively physical mobility can now be organised as a **combination** of a **physical mobility abroad** and of a **learning period online** either before or after the physical part.



Two possible scenarios of blended mobility:

1. **Long-term physical presence abroad:** minimum 2 months physical presence abroad complemented by any volume of virtual learning before or after the physical mobility (for students on study mobility or traineeship mobility)
2. **Short-term physical presence abroad:** minimum 5 days and a maximum of 30 days abroad complemented by any volume of virtual learning before or after the physical mobility (for students on study mobility or traineeships)

Which requirements apply?




Blended mobility is planned from the beginning, prior to start of your activity abroad.

The virtual component can be planned either before or after the physical part.

The physical part (abroad) should have a minimum duration: 2 months for long-term mobility; 5 days for short-term mobility.

The short-term student mobility should be taken up in particular by those students who cannot go on a long-term physical mobility.

The University will assess the appropriateness of such a choice and make sure that long-term physical mobilities remain the norm.

The **International office** assists you during the selection and before your departure or arrival, providing information on needed documents, and supporting you for administrative procedures.
