**Procedure for the selection of staff**

Each University, included in the project, will carry out the selection of the participants according to the following **criteria**:

1. The selection must be fair, transparent and well-documented, and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process.
2. The selection criteria shall be made public and according to the following criteria:
  - a. Candidate's CV, including English or Italian level proficiency (maximum 40 pts);
  - b. Mobility agreement (maximum 40 pts)\*;
  - c. Further certifications (maximum 20 pts).

**\* Priority given to mobility agreements aimed at training activities in specific interdisciplinary academic fields:**

- *RealMaths programme* (activities oriented to the management of double degree programme *Mathematics for Real World Applications*),
- *Cyber Security* (activities oriented to the development of new cooperations and to the participation to a Staff Week and/or to an intensive programme on *An interdisciplinary approach to Cyber Security*);
- *Modeling and HPC* (activities oriented to the development of new cooperations and to the participation to a Staff Week and/or to intensive programme on *Mathematical modelling and HPC simulation*).

**Minimum score: 60/100 pts**

The HEI shall take the necessary measures to prevent any conflict of interest with regard to persons who may be invited to take part in the selection bodies or selection process.

Each University will send the International Relations Office ([credit.mobility@struttura.univaq.it](mailto:credit.mobility@struttura.univaq.it)):

- the minutes of the selection;
  - an Excel file with all the information regarding candidates and scores given according to the selection criteria listed above;
  - an official nomination letter;
- b. Documents to be sent to UNIVAQ for each selected candidate:
- candidate's CV;
  - training agreement proposal;
  - a copy of the passport;
  - Further certifications

**Partner Universities will select a maximum of 3 staff member.**

**Deadline: 31<sup>st</sup> January 2026**

**Staff mobility must end by 31<sup>st</sup> July 2026.**

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**The budget available for this call corresponds to all the remaining funds allocated for Region 9 of the project.**

Once all documents arrive from all Partner universities, an academic committee at UNIVAQ will be nominated in order to evaluate the applications received. A selection will be made and a single ranking will be created (by merit).

Among those eligible, the best among the eligible candidates of: University of Kinshasa, Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology, Akenten Appiah-Menka University of Skills Training and Entrepreneurial Development, African Institute For Mathematical Science - Ghana (one position each, max four position in total) will have priority in assigning a position.

The remaining funds available at the moment of the selection will be used to select the best candidates from the remaining candidates in the single ranking (regardless of their institution of affiliation).

The single ranking of eligible candidates remains valid until the end of the project (July 2026): if additional funds become available (including from other countries in the same region), the single ranking will be used as long as there are still eligible candidates on the list.
