Procedure for the selection of students

Each University, included in the project, will carry out the selection of the participants according to the **following criteria**:

1. The selection must be fair, transparent and well-documented, and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process.

In order to promote equity and inclusion, partners shall encourage the participation of students with fewer opportunities¹. In the evaluation and selection process in case of equivalent academic merit,

2. The selection shall be made public and according to the following criteria:

¹ examples of what can constitute a barrier for participation in its section: 1. Disabilities; 2. Health problems; 3. Barriers linked to education and training systems; 4. Cultural differences; 5. Social barriers; 6. Barriers linked to discrimination; 7. Geographical barriers.

- a) candidate's CV (maximum 15 pts);
- b) motivation letter (maximum 10 pts);
- c) learning agreement for studies – proposal (maximum 15 pts)
- d) transcript of records (maximum 30 pts);
- e) level of English and/or Italian level proficiency (maximum 20 pts)
- f) Further certifications (maximum 10 pts)

The minimum score to be eligible is 60/100.

Participant with fewer opportunities additional score: 20 pts

Fewer opportunities must be officially proved by submitting the documentary evidence.

The selected beneficiary included in the main list of grantees shall be awarded a top-up amount of € 250,00 per month, in addition to the monthly scholarship.

The HEI shall take the necessary measures to prevent any conflict of interest with regard to persons who may be invited to take part in the selection bodies or selection process.

3. Lower priority will be given to those who have already participated in mobility actions in the same study cycle under the LLP-Erasmus Programme, Erasmus Mundus Programme or Erasmus+ Programme.

In the case of Erasmus Mundus Master Courses and Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees, previous participation is only taken into account for scholarship holders. A student can go on mobility several times, up to a maximum of 12 months per study cycle. Prior experience under LLP- Erasmus Programme; Erasmus+ mobility for higher education students (both KA103 and KA107/171) and as scholarship holders of Erasmus Mundus Master Courses and Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree is taken into account for the maximum of 12 months. However, participation in Erasmus Mundus Master Courses and Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees as self-financing participants is not taken into account.

4. priority will be given to students enrolled in double degree master programmes.

Each University, included in the project,:

- g) will inform UNIVAQ International Relations Office (credit.mobility@strutture.univaq.it) by sending:
 - the minutes of the selection.
 - an Excel file with all the information regarding candidates and scores given according to the selection criteria stated in point 2
 - an official nomination letter
- h) Documents to be sent to UNIVAQ for each student candidate:
 - candidate's CV;
 - motivation letter;
 - learning agreement for studies proposal;
 - transcript of records;
 - fewer opportunities documentary evidence;
 - a copy of the passport;
 - **detailed information regarding previous participation in the Erasmus+ Program** (duration, level of study, type of project, hosting Institution) or **declaration of non-participation in the Erasmus+ Program;**
 - **declaration of the enrolment at the sending institution;**
 - certificate of English/Italian level proficiency
 - Further certifications

Deadline: 31st January 2026

Once all documents arrive from all Partner universities, an academic committee at UNIVAQ will be nominated in order to evaluate the applications received. A general merit ranking will be approved by the committee together with a reserve list of candidates.

The student mobility will start in the second semester of the academic year 2025/2026 and must end by 31st July 2026.
