Procedure for the selection of staff

The University will carry out the selection of the participants according to the following criteria:

1. The selection must be fair, transparent and well-documented, and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process.
2. The selection criteria shall be made public, and according to the following criteria:

Candidate's CV, including English or Italian level proficiency (maximum 40 pts);

Mobility agreement (maximum 40 pts);

Further certifications (maximum 20 pts).

Minimum score: 60/100 pts

The HEI shall take the necessary measures to prevent any conflict of interest with regard to persons who may be invited to take part in the selection bodies or selection process.

- An official nomination letter (form provided)

Documents to be uploaded for each candidate - section 3

1. Candidate's CV (form provided)

4. Further certifications (if available);

Partner Institutions may select up to 4 staff members.

Deadline: 28/04/2026

Once all documents arrive from all Partner universities, an academic committee at UNIVAQ will be nominated in order to evaluate the applications received. A selection will be made, and a single ranking will be created (by merit) together with a reserve list of candidates. The selection process will prioritise the two highest-ranked eligible applicants per institution.

The staff mobility will start in the second semester of the academic year 2025/2026 or in the first semester of the academic year 2026/2027.
