Procedure for the selection of students

Each University, included in the project, will carry out the selection of the participants according to the following **criteria**:

1. The selection must be fair, transparent and well-documented, and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process.

In order to promote equity and inclusion, partners shall encourage the participation of students with fewer opportunities¹. In the evaluation and selection process in case of equivalent academic merit,

2. The selection shall be made public and according to the following criteria:

- a) candidate's CV (maximum 15 pts);
- b) motivation letter (maximum 15 pts);

¹ examples of what can constitute a barrier for participation in its section: 1. Disabilities; 2. Health problems; 3. Barriers linked to education and training systems; 4. Cultural differences; 5. Social barriers; 6. Barriers linked to discrimination; 7. Geographical barriers.

- c) transcript of records (maximum 30 pts);
- d) level of English level proficiency - minimum B1 - (maximum 15 pts)
- e) level of Italian level Proficiency - minimum B1 - (maximum 15 pts)
- f) Further certifications (maximum 10 pts)

The minimum score to be eligible is 60/100.

Participant with fewer opportunities additional score: 20 pts

Fewer opportunities must be officially proved by submitting the documentary evidence.

The selected beneficiary included in the main list of grantees shall be awarded a top-up amount of € 250,00 per month, in addition to the monthly scholarship.

The HEI shall take the necessary measures to prevent any conflict of interest with regard to persons who may be invited to take part in the selection bodies or selection process.

3. Lower priority will be given to those who have already participated in mobility actions in the same study cycle under the LLP-Erasmus Programme, Erasmus Mundus Programme or Erasmus+ Programme.

In the case of Erasmus Mundus Master Courses and Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees, previous participation is only taken into account for scholarship holders. A student can go on mobility several times, up to a maximum of 12 months per study cycle. Prior experience under LLP- Erasmus Programme; Erasmus+ mobility for higher education students (both KA103 and KA107) and as scholarship holders of Erasmus Mundus Master Courses and Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree is taken into account for the maximum of 12 months. However, participation in Erasmus Mundus Master Courses and Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees as self-financing participants is not taken into account.

Each University, included in the project,:

 - an official nomination letter

Procedure for the selection of staff

Each University, included in the project, will carry out the selection of the participants according to the following **criteria**:

1. The selection must be fair, transparent and well-documented, and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process.
2. The selection criteria shall be made public.
 - a. candidate's CV (maximum 30 pts);
 - b. mobility agreement (achievement of real enrichment of teaching/technical/administrative capacities of both hosting and visiting staff; Commitment of home institution to recognize the activities carried out abroad; Contribution of the mobility to capacity building of sending institutions; Opportunity to start/extend an integrated curriculum / double diploma. Level of integration of proposed teaching/training activities in the hosting institution) - (maximum 30 pts);
 - c. certificate of English/Italian level proficiency (maximum 20 pts);
 - d. Further certifications (maximum 20 pts)

The HEI shall take the necessary measures to prevent any conflict of interest with regard to persons who may be invited to take part in the selection bodies or selection process.

Each University:

- b. will send the International Relations Office (credit.mobility@strutture.univaq.it):
 - the minutes of the selection;
 - an Excel file with all the information regarding candidates and scores given according to the selection criteria;
