Your proposal should include:

- A very brief biography highlighting your expertise and experience (no more than one page)
- Title of the webinar
- A summary (up to 300 words) of your proposed session, including key topics and objectives
- Possible date and time of the webinar and, if possible, two or three alternatives

- Any additional resources or tools you would like to share during the webinar
